ANNUNAL REPORT OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (Tailoring)

January 2025 to December 2025

Introduction

Skill development Program (Tailoring for the poor and marginalized women and girls) also is one of the main activities of the Navjeevan Educational and Social Society Digha. Through tailoring we mainly focus on **all-round development of each student and make them self-confident and self-supportive**. In this centre they are given many opportunities to grow as fully human beings. Navjeevan tailoring centre takes keen interest in each one to bring out their talents and abilities and the sense of art .

This skill has very good scope for the future. Our students are mainly from slums. All of them belong to very poor families and they are given the chance to grow as fully human beings. So it is a very good chance for them to develop one self and to grow with dignity and self-respect. They take keen interest in learning. We pay attention to each student without any religion or caste difference. (Caste difference is very much practised in Bihar). We give them the message that we all are brothers and sisters and we have to live in peace and harmony by respecting every one. We also give them awareness sessions on Health, education, atrocities on women, communicable and non-communicable disease etc. our students are from very poor and marginalised families and some centres are in the slums.

Last year we had tailoring centres only in the villages and slums. This year we have centres in four places and we are happy to say that out of four centres one is in Navjeevan itself. This year we have extended the duration of the course months to three and six months.(5th and sixth batch three months i.e. Kamala Nehru nagar and Jabalpur 1.)And 7th and 8th batch six months (jalalpur 2.) Because they suggested that they need at least six months to be become perfect and will be able to manage by their own.

We have completed 4 batches last year and this year two batches completed and certificates are given. Two batches are still continuing. After the completion of the course most of them are self-employed or employed by other tailors hence they started to earn and become self-reliant. At the end of the course they are given certificates.

1st meeting

We had meeting with women and young girls who were interested in learning tailoring. Also few parents were present. We discussed about starting of tailoring center. Time , place and the day of inauguration were decided with them according to their convenience.

Decisions taken:

1. Monday to Friday.1pm to 4pm
2. Duration of the course: three months.
3. Mrs. Usha Devi is appointed as teacher by NESWSD.
4. We have decided to have Inauguration and starting of the Tailoring on 26.06.2025.

6th Batch in Jabalpur village

In Jabalpur village we have two tailoring centers in different centers. 1st batch started on 15th July 2025 and completed on 15th October and given certificate.

Manisha Kumari is the Teacher in Jabalpur both the centers. She is teaching them to make mask first on the paper and afterwards on the cloth. Within three months they have learned to make all types of clothes which women and girls wear. E.g. salwar suite, kurti, skirt, petticoat, blouse etc. in different designs fashions.

Along with tailoring we give trainings in different subjects. Sr. Tessa is giving class on the importance of educating the children and the need to give them balanced diet avoiding the Junk food.

TRAINING ON HERBAL MEDICINE



Iron Tonic from Maringa Oleifera leaves



Materials Needed

Maringa leaves



Jaggery



Glass Jar

We have explained well to the students how to make Iron Tonic from Maringa leaves (Drumstick). We also explained why it is called miracle Tree.

Maringa is called the "miracle tree" because nearly every part of it is edible and packed with an extraordinary amount of nutrients (vitamins, minerals, protein, and antioxidants) and beneficial compounds, making it a powerful super food and traditional medicine for combating malnutrition and various ailments. Its leaves are exceptionally rich in iron, calcium, vitamin C, protein, and all essential amino acids, earning it names like "[Tree of Life](#)".

REHABILITATION OF DIFFERENTLY ABLED



Community based Rehabilitation of differently abled is another activity of NESWSD. We have regular meetings with them to know about their progress and problems. This meeting is a great help. It gives them a feeling that they are not alone and there is somebody cares for them, also it is a good opportunity for them to meet others and share their happiness and sorrows. We have identified 145 differently abled. Also we are helping ten children of differently abled parents for studies. Out of ten six children's both parents are polio affected and are either on the wheel chair or walking by calipers. There are more children who need our help. They are from Harnaut. Since we left Harnaut nobody is taking care of them.

Our goal of Community based rehabilitation program is to achieve the maximum function and adjustment of the individual and to prepare them physically, mentally, socially and vocationally for the fullest possible life compatible with his abilities and disabilities.

- Our first priority for these children is his social and emotional development. Children with physical challenges often have difficulty with relationships because of their physical limitations.
- Moving through each stage of development, including social, emotional, and intellectual as well as physical development, is much harder for them — but still do-able.
- Being the community based venture it gives us greater opportunity to interact with the families and communities on regular basis
- We provide education up to graduation, medical and social rehabilitation (e.g. Surgery, tricycle, callipers, vocational training, tailoring, tailoring machine, small shops as IGP etc.).

Activities

- **Regular visit to their homes and coaching centres.**
- **Medical treatment:** help is given to them for Surgery to correct deformity, for medical treatment etc.

- **Income generation activity:** we also help for small income generation activities

activities. Mansodhr Kumar was given help to buy E. Richaw two years back with he earned money and he started a small shop. His wife also is handicapped (Dwalf) and when Mansodhar, her Husband, goes with passengers she sits in the shop. Like that both of them are earning some income for the family. He has two children. We are helping them for their studies

- **Monthly meeting:** Monthly meeting helps to know about their progress, problems etc. it also is a good opportunity for them to meet their companions and exchange their happiness and sorrows. During meeting awareness classes are given on different subject like health, protection of environment, communicable diseases and their preventions, HIVAIDS, personal and environmental hygiene, different sickness, its causes and prevention and the importance of spending time for studies.

- **Financial Help for their studies:** Tuition fees, College registration fees, text books, copy books dresses etc. are given to them according to their need. Also personal attention is given to each child.

Alock Kumar is a polio affected child. He is studying in class two. His both legs are affected by polio. It was corrected to some extend by 1st Surgery. Now he had One more surgery in November 2025, now he is can walk slowly. He started going to school.
